

Community Telephone Survey

- Primary goal:
 - Measure level of community support for a new library
 - Determine community preference for location
 - Identify sales tax funding option preference for library
- Survey conducted after one week of community discussion.
- Random sample of 580 Grand Forks residents, stratified by Ward (sampling margin of error +/- 4.0%).




Sample size 80-86 per Ward






Respondent age grouping





Respondent level of education






Level of household income






Respondent gender






Respondent home owners/renters






Have children under 12 at home






Have children age 12-18 at home






Computer access at home










Anticipated usage at new library




















- A HALF CENT SALES TAX FOR 6-7 YEARS
- A ONE CENT SALES TAX FOR 3-4 YEARS









- Preference for funding option is half-cent sales tax spread over 6-7 years.
 - Preference is relatively small, but cuts across almost all demographics.
